At 18: 1,955 students left 33 UTCs¹

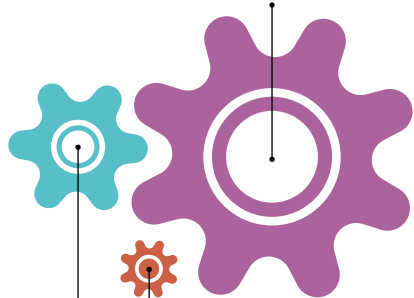
97%
