Dear Parent/ Carer,

RE: Spring term 2021 – information for year 10 students on Remote Learning.

Following the announcement of a national lockdown and that all schools were to close and move to remote learning I am writing to provide you with the information you will need to ensure that your child is able to successfully access their learning over the coming weeks. The government have announced that schools are likely to be closed until at least February half term and so it is essential that you are confident in your child's ability to access this learning.

Google Classroom will be used to deliver all remote learning and all students are familiar with this platform and have the codes to access each on line classroom for each lesson. Staff are experienced with the delivery of remote learning and have effectively used this previously to guarantee that learning is active and appropriate. I have included an Appendix 1 to this letter setting out guidance for the use of Google Classroom for your information and how to access support.

From Monday 11th January our remote learning timetable will incorporate some live lessons, some recorded lessons and some set work for all students following each student's normal weekly timetable. This will provide a range of engaging tasks and the opportunity for virtual face to face contact with their usual teachers each week. We have identified where these live lessons are on your child's current timetable of lessons and listed these for your information at Appendix 2. It is expected that all students access and complete all classes each week. Staff will monitor attendance and engagement with learning on a daily and weekly basis.

After a hugely successful first term at the UTC for year 10 it is essential that students in year 10 maintain their commitment to making excellent progress in their learning despite the lockdown. It is therefore essential that students understand that work produced in this period of remote learning will contribute to and impact on attainment, assessment grades and outcomes. It will also impact on their future destinations at the end of year 11 and beyond. APPENDIX 1

Using Google Classroom to support remote learning.

In order that you as parents are able to support your child in their remote learning I wanted to provide some detailed guidance on the expectations we have for this type of learning as follows:

- Students should access their learning in line with their normal timetable and will have access to their teachers for support and guidance at this time. Some teachers will teach live lessons or provide recordings, others will set clear structured work to be completed during the timetabled lessons.
- Please ensure that your child attends these lessons so that they do not fall behind in their learning during the first week of the new term.
- All work will contribute to progress, attainment and assessment.
- If you believe that your son/daughter will struggle to access these lessons due to computer hardware issues do let us know.
- Lesson attendance and work completed will be monitored by teachers and followed up as necessary.
- All lessons and learning will be delivered through the relevant Google Classroom for that subject.
- If a student cannot attend the lesson and there is a legitimate reason they will be able to access that lesson stream and complete the work at a later date. All work set must be completed.
